As always, another busy year for work in and around the church, hall and grounds has passed with routine maintenance of the buildings and grounds to more major jobs on the Hall.

New window panes were installed in the corridor and meeting room to replace the blown ones. A new gas heater was installed in the meeting room after a routine inspection discovered a fault with the old one. An old heater was also removed from the vestry. This will now allow the vestry to be updated with new storage facilities.

Towards the end of the year the floor in the hall was sanded and re-sealed. It now looks amazing!
